

1 Corinthians

Chapter 10:1-33

Paul's discussion of eating meats sacrificed to idols concludes in this section. He uses Israel of the Old Testament as an illustration of God's people being entangled in idolatry and suffering God's wrath.

1. Explain the sense in which Israel was "baptized unto Moses" (10:2)
2. What is the value of the Old Testament for us (10:6, 11)?
3. Search for the events mentioned in 10:7-10 and explain how these connect to Corinth.
4. Note the promises made by the Lord (10:13).
5. With whom does a Christian have fellowship when partaking of the Lord's Supper (10:16, 17)?
6. What happens when a person participates in idol worship and how does this inform our conduct regarding modern man made religions (10:18-20)?
7. What are we to do if we are specifically told a certain action is devoted to sinful purposes and why (10:27-30)?
